

Crosspoint LEED™ Contribution for New Construction

The <u>LEED[™] Rating System Points Accrual Process</u> is broken down into many credit identifiers. However, the following categories are the only ones pertaining to wall covering qualifications for Ô[[••][∄ œÁtyle Tiara — all falling within the Materials & Resources, Indoor Environmental Quality, and/or Innovation in Design categories.

In order to acquire this LEED credit, the building site must be less than 500 miles from these locations. Details as to the specific location where raw materials are supplied from are unavailable at this time. A percentage of this product may be considered as recovered or extracted. | Tiara is manufactured in Dalton, GA 30720. 50% of product is recovered. |
